Poster and Student Research Sessions

Poster Sessions

All poster sessions will be 30 minutes. The first 15 minutes will be for the presentation and the final 15 minutes will allow attendees the opportunity to ask questions. CEUs earned will reflect the longer duration for 0.5 CEUs and 0.05 ASHA CEUs.

Please note a maximum of 3 poster sessions can be attended and 1.5, 0.15 CEUs can be earned in one 90 minute block. To identify poster sessions, in the app or our interactive program, filter by Presentation Type> Poster Session. 'This session is a Poster Session' is also featured within all poster session descriptions.

Student Research Presentations

Student Research Presentations are comprised of six 15-minute presentations within a 90-minute presentation.

To identify student research presentations in the app or our interactive program, filter by Presentation Type> Student Research Presentation. 'This session is a Student Research Presentation' also featured within all Student Research presentation descriptions.

FAQ

How many CEUs can I earn at Convergence?

This program meets the qualifications for a maximum of 28.5 hours of continuing professional development credit for Speech-Language Pathologists and Audiologists as required by the California Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology and Hearing Aid Dispensers Board.

The session I want to attend is full. Can I still attend?

We will allow a five-minute grace period for attendees on a session's roster to find their seats. If after five minutes seats remain, you can attend the session on a first come first served basis.

What is the difference between the help desk and the registration area?

CSHA volunteers will be located at both stations, but each area serves a different purpose.

Help Desk

The help desk can answer any questions you have about the conference. If you need help adding a session to your transcript, you should visit the help desk.



Two help desks will be available onsite to assist you with any questions you may have. Help Desk 1 is in the foyer of the primary conference building. Help Desk 2 is in the foyer on the second floor of the Conference Building.

Registration

Registration is outside of Exhibit Hall A be where you check-in, print your badge printing, and can register on site.

When will I receive a record of the courses I attended and a transcript with my conference CEUs?

All Convergence certificates will be sent by the end of the day on Friday, March 21, 2025.

To ensure the sessions you attended appear on your certificate, you must make sure to enter the unique code for each session you attend **before** the scheduled end time of each session. If you

have trouble scanning a session, please visit the Help Desk and our friendly staff or volunteers will be able to assist.
